- d) The protection of children from harm.


Please ensure we receive any further information on or before the close of the consultation period on 19th December 2018.

We have had a number of issues with the William Wygston. Since moving to this area. Which was four and a half years ago.

Our property is seperated from the above pub. By litrally inches.

After shortly moving in we had to endure a terrible noise that was coming from the mechanics and workings of the public house. Which just so happens to be at the bottom of our garden. This took us within the region of a whole year to sort out. Only with the help of the manageress who was working at the William Wygston at that time. Unfortunatly it meant we were unable to sit in our garden for the said period of time. We have constantly had to complain to the manager. With issues arising at the back of the building. As this area also ajoines the back of our property. The issues are. Noise very late at night into the early hours of the morning. Mainly with staff. One incident recently took place where. On one of the Many Numerouse occasions I have had to get out of my bed. And lean over the boundry wall To tell them to be quiet. Which is not ideal at 12 pm at night. The two chefs were arguing. I did go round the next day to complain to the management. Who explained she wasnt sure who was on that shift but she would try and find out. We also have noise as regards emptying beer barrels. Which can be from 12 PM and onwards.

We have also On numerouse occasions experienced loud music noise.

On one occasion my husband got out of his bed to go round at 2PM. In the morning. They had men working in the pub with drills. Which kept us awake all night.

We now have been told a beer garden has been proposed at the above site.

How much more noise will we have to tolarate from this area.?
