- Dealing with complaints and reports of alleged food poisoning (9 in total)
- 90% compliance rate, with 31 premises awaiting inspection
- Sampling to commence 2023/24
- Q3 all high risk premises all completed
- 12 B's and Cs to carry out in Q4 along with 77 other lower risk inspections
- Noticed a drop off in standards from some previously highly rated premises which will impact on Q4 compliance rate
