Allocation of Vacant Seats on Committees (Political Balance Following By-Election)

Author(s): Anne Court (Interim Chief Executive)

#### 1. Introduction

To agree changes to proportionality following the recent by-election and to appoint accordingly to the vacant seats on those affected Committees, Boards, Panels, Forums and Working Groups (collectively hereafter as "Committees") of the Council.

### 2. Recommendation(s)

- 2.1. The changes to proportionality arrangements, as set out at Appendix A, be approved.
- 2.2. In accordance with the proportionality arrangements, the necessary amendments and appointments be made to the memberships of those affected Committees and the Members to serve thereon, as set out at Appendix B.

#### 3. Information

- 3.1. The resignation of Councillor Gurpal S Atwal in July 2017 led to a single vacancy in the Oadby Uplands Ward. A by-election was held on 21 September 2017 which saw the election of the candidate for the Liberal Democrats, Councillor Lily Kaufman.
- 3.2. As a result, there are vacant seats on some Committees of the Council (as set out at **Appendix B**) due to the shift in the political balance of the Council following this by-election (as set out at **Appendix A**) as summarised at paragraph 3.6 of this report.
- 3.3. The requirements as to political proportionality in the membership of committees are embodied in the Local Government (Committees and Political Groups) Regulations 1990 made under sections 15 and 16 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989.
- 3.4. It is a statutory requirement that where a relevant authority has a membership divided into different political groups, then the decision-making bodies on the Council must be proportional to the overall make-up of the Council. The Monitoring Officer has a statutory responsibility for ensuring the Council implements proportionality correctly.
- 3.5. In implementing proportionality correctly, consideration must be given to the following four principles as far as is reasonable practicable:
  - i. all the seats are not allocated to the same political group;
  - **ii.** the majority of the seats go to the political group in the majority on the full Council;
  - **iii.** subject to the above two principles, the total number of seats on the ordinary committees of the Authority are allocated to each political group in the same proportion as the group's representation on the full Council; and
  - **iv.** subject to the above three principles, the number of seats on each committee are allocated to each political group in the same proportion as the group's

representation on the Council.

3.6. In summary, the following amendments to the memberships of the following affected Committees as a result of the recent by-election are hereby proposed:
