

## **Matters Arising from the Minutes of the Previous Meeting held on February 28<sup>th</sup> 2018**

### **Page1 and Page 2**

#### **Draft articles and terms of reference for the residents' forums actions.**

Wording as agreed at the previous Residents' Forum meeting was incorporated into the draft terms of reference. The terms of reference have been agreed by the Full Council.

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#### **Air Quality ASR Update 2017. Clarification of the figures coloured red and orange**

The following clarifies the question raised by some residents as to the meaning of colour coding on the update paper circulated at the meeting.

Red means exceeds air quality objective 40 µg<sup>3</sup>.

Orange means above the level DEFRA advise Local Authority should be monitoring the Air Quality 36 µg<sup>3</sup> but below 40 µg<sup>3</sup>.

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The management of Brocks Hill Centre as yet has not been signed over to SLM company management. Consequently, there is no information currently available with regards to savings.

#### **Siting of a bench at Florence Wragge Way**

The request for additional funds of £435.00 to conclude the placing and installation of the bench was endorsed by PFD (Policy, Finance and Delivery) Committee on 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2018 .

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#### **Placing of a litter bin sited on Fludes Lane on an area between Sainsbury Store and Fairfield Road.**

Following Council investigation as to the feasibility of moving the double size litterbin on Fludes Lane, and placing it on the pavement between Sainsbury store and Fairfield Road, officers concurred that: the litter bin cannot be re-sited on the pavement as; bin is a double bin, made specifically for Fludes Lane and is very well used. It was acknowledged that a single bin could definitely usefully be placed on the pavement between Sainsbury Store and Fairfield Road to deal with the litter issue as long as the Forum was open to paying for its purchase and installation.

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#### **Siting of the Sandhurst Road Commemorative Stones**

A proposal for the costing to mount the stones along with an interpretation panel was agreed to the sum of £1,00 on, 28<sup>th</sup> February 2018 and endorsed by PFD ( Policy, ,Finance and Delivery) Committee on May 2<sup>nd</sup> 2018.A design with words and a drawing is required from the Forum to submit to the Council`s furniture officer. This is in progress.

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**Oadby Community Response Group Application to fund a community leaflet**

A proposal for the design and printing of a community leaflet costing £1,574.88 was endorsed by the PFD Committee on May 2<sup>nd</sup> 2018.

Oadby Library Service Changes is on the agenda for discussion.

It has been concluded that as Phoenix Therapy Service was not requested to agree to provide a written report before the new funding regime was put in place a subsequent report request is not required.
