Chair`s Updates

a) Capital Projects Update

The Framework Knitters Museum

The Framework Knitters Museum gates repair project was endorsed by PFD (Policy, Finance and Development) Committee. The work is complete. £400 was awarded by the Wigston Residents Forum to fund this project. An application form was received in support of this application.

The Peace Memorial Park Badge Flowerbed Frame

The Peace Memorial Park Badge Flowerbed Frame repair proposal was awarded £100 . The award was endorsed by PFD (Policy, Finance and Development) Committee. An application form was received in support of this application. The work is complete.

Litterbin Installed near to the Firs Properties

The request for a litterbin to be installed near to the Firs properties on Oadby Road is complete. The litterbin cost £450.

Electrical Work to install an electrical source for charging a Defibrillator.

The Defibrillator previously to be placed outside Sainsbury`s Superstore on Bell Street is to be installed by Elizabeth Court flats. An electrical installation to maintain a charge of the Defibrillator is to be installed. Sainsbury Superstore was unable to install the Defibrillator as their company electricians were going to charge them £2000.This was viewed as too expensive a cost.

The repairs to the safety surface at Horsewell Lane play area have been completed. The play area is now open to users.
