As you are aware Central Government funding for councils has been reduced significantly and the government now expects local government to raise the majority of its finances locally.

This has put considerable strain on all councils to raise funds to provide services to our residents.


Only 12% of the council tax raised in the Borough goes to Oadby and Wigston.

The promise that all monies spent on Covid would be repaid, in fact only 76 pence for each pound spent has been reimbursed. This puts further strain on the councils finances.

We propose the Council delegate to the Leader/ Deputy Leader and senior officers the authority to halt plans to bring in the extension of parking charges, should Neil O'Brien MP deliver by 31st October 2021 sustainable long term funding of at least £170.000 per annum. This is the current annual cost to the council of maintaining the car parks.
